- Learn from the Apostle Paul about life in the Early Church, how Jesus Christ was seen by hundreds of people after the Resurrection, include the Apostle himself.
- How would you respond if Jesus Christ said to give everything away and follow Him?
- Why should we love God above all other things in our life?

#### Building on the Cornerstone

September 19, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** 1 Corinthians 16:13-24  
Galatians 2:16-20 (Cross)

**Gospel:** Matthew 21:33-42

**Tone/Mode:** Mark 8:34-9:1 (Cross)

- It's been nearly five months since Holy Week and Pascha, and we again see the Cross placed in the middle of the Church, for our veneration and contemplation of its meaning in our life.
- What would you say if Jesus Christ asked to tell Him about the fruits of your spiritual labors?
- How can we live according to the gospel message and live in the 21<sup>st</sup> century world?

### ✠ Week 3: 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

#### In the Presence of God

September 26, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** 2 Corinthians 1:21-2:4

**Gospel:** Luke 5:1-11

**Tone/Mode:** 5 (Plagal 1)

- Twelve men came from different backgrounds, yet all became followers and Apostles of Jesus Christ, and we are called to be like them. Would you?
- What would you do if someone started picking on you because you're an Orthodox Christian?
- Why is having hope in God important both in the good and bad times?

### ✠ Week 4: 15<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

#### Be Merciful as Your Father

October 3, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** 2 Corinthians 4:6-15

**Gospel:** Luke 6:31-36

**Tone/Mode:** 6 (Plagal 2)

- Treating other people with dignity and respect is something we're all taught, because we're followers of Jesus Christ who loves us more than we love ourselves.
- How would you react if you saw someone in need on the street?
- Did you ever help someone without expecting anything in return from them?

### ✠ Week 5: 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

#### Being a Cheerful Giver

October 10, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** 2 Corinthians 6:1-10

**Gospel:** Luke 7:11-16

**Tone/Mode:** 7 (Plagal 3)

- Learn from the Apostle Paul why patience is an important part of our life - what can we learn from this reading about how to live?
- Jesus Christ raises the young man from the dead - what does this say about God?
- How can we be part of the Body of Christ in our local parish?

### ✠ Week 6: 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

#### Sowing the Seeds

October 17, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** 2 Corinthians 6:16-7:1  
Titus 3:8-15

**Gospel:** Luke 8:5-15

**Tone/Mode:** John 17:1-13  
8 (Plagal 4)

- Explore the parable of the sower, taking a few moment to pray and reflect on the type of soil we have for the Word of God to dwell and grow in our life.
- How do we live as Orthodox Christians in our relationship with others?
- Why do Christians suffer - shouldn't things be easy since we believe in God?

## Lesson Plan Overview

October 24 - December 4, 2021

### ✠ Week 1: 18<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost **In Fear, Faith, and Love**

October 24, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** 2 Corinthians 9:6-11

**Gospel:** Luke 8:26-39

**Tone/Mode:** 1

- In the gospels, very few people recognize or proclaim Jesus as God - but the demons do, suggesting that we need to understand Christ on a spiritual level - not from an earthly perspective.
- Why did the demons want to get away from Jesus so quickly?
- Faith and works - what must we do to inherit eternal life?

### ✠ Week 2: 19<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost **Seize the Moment**

October 31, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** 2 Corinthians 11:31-12:9

**Gospel:** Luke 16:19-31

**Tone/Mode:** 2

- The memory of our ancestors and the departed is a frequent occasion in the Church. We sing "Memory Eternal," keeping them close to us, as they stand in the presence of God in Heaven.
- What can we do to live with a sense of urgency to be prepared for eternity?
- How did the apostles and the faithful in the early church live their daily lives?

### ✠ Week 3: 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost **Who Touched Me?**

November 7, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** Galatians 1:11-19

**Gospel:** Luke 8:41-56

**Tone/Mode:** 3

- Each of us has a guardian angel and we know from scripture there are legions of angels ministering to God. These celestial beings aren't cute and playful, but messengers and warriors of God.
- Why does St. Paul tell us that to be Christian is to accept suffering?
- How does Jesus reveal His divinity while interacting with people in the gospel?

### ✠ Week 4: 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday after Pentecost **Who is My Neighbor?**

November 14, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** 1 Corinthians 4:9-16

**Gospel:** Luke 10:25-37

**Tone/Mode:** 4

- Tomorrow begins the Advent fast, meaning we're 40 days before the feast of Our Lord's Nativity. To prepare for the coming of Christ, we begin fasting, more prayer, and service to others - so that we may offer ourselves in the cave, before our newborn Lord.
- How would you react if you saw someone in need on the street?
- Can we freely give of our possessions to help others?

### ✠ Week 5: 22<sup>nd</sup> Sunday after Pentecost **Members of God's Household**

November 21, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** Galatians 6:11-18

**Gospel:** Luke 12:16-21

**Tone/Mode:** 5 (Plagal 1)

- How do we act as members of God's Household?
- How does a Christian live their life knowing that tomorrow is not guaranteed?
- How do we welcome all people into God's house?

### ✠ Week 6: 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday after Pentecost **God is Our Treasure**

November 28, 2021

**Epistle/Apostol:** Ephesians 2:4-10

**Gospel:** Luke 18:18-27

**Tone/Mode:** 6 (Plagal 2)

- Who is the image of the invisible God?
- Why is it hard for a rich person to enter the Kingdom of Heaven?
- What can we do to be perfect like God?
